MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Wear of the United States Army Class B Uniform

1. Reference memorandum, CSA, DACS-ZA, 19 August 2011, subject: Wear of the Army Uniform for Personnel at the Pentagon (enclosure).
2. Effective 1 October 2011, all Soldiers assigned, attached, or with permanent duty at the Army National Guard (ARNG) Directorate will wear the Army Class B uniform as the standard duty uniform when they are present for duty in the Military District of Washington (MDW).
3. Soldiers have the option of wearing either the Army Service Uniform or the Army Green Uniform. The Army Green Uniform is authorized for wear until 30 September 2015.
4. All Soldiers arriving for temporary duty (TDY) to Arlington Hall Station, the Pentagon, or other ARNG Directorate office locations in the MDW area will wear the Class B uniform.
5. The Beret is the primary headgear worn with the Class B uniform. The Service Cap may be worn during ceremonies or when circumstances warrant.
6. Soldiers who are traveling on TDY to other locations outside of the MDW area will wear the required uniform as determined by the lead agency or command for the TDY event.
7. Soldiers performing duties that may damage or render the Class B uniform unserviceable (e.g., firing range detail, supply room activities, or technology installation) can wear the Army Combat Uniform instead of the Class B uniform. Soldiers will return to the standard duty uniform upon completion of those duties. This authorization can be made by division chiefs on a case-by-case basis.
8. In order to support the 1 October 2011 implementation date, a one-time supplemental issue of Army Service Uniform items will be given to enlisted Soldiers assigned, attached, or with permanent duty to the ARNG Directorate.

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Wear of the Army Uniform for Personnel at the Pentagon

- 1. Effective 1 October 2011, the Class A or B Army Service Uniform (ASU)/Army Green Uniform will be the standard duty uniform for all Soldiers assigned, attached or with permanent duty at the Pentagon. The Army Green uniform is authorized for wear until 30 September 2015, IAW ALARACT Message 099-2011.**
- 2. Those Soldiers who are assigned to organizations within the Pentagon, but due to space restrictions operate from offices in the National Capital Region will also adhere to this policy. Army Personnel arriving to the Pentagon on temporary duty (TDY) will be informed by sponsoring agencies that the prescribed uniform while TDY to the Pentagon, including those organizations assigned to the Pentagon that operate from offices in the National Capital Region, is the Class A or B uniform. Pentagon personnel traveling on TDY will wear the prescribed uniform of the organization they are going TDY to support.**
- 3. The Beret is the primary headgear worn with the Class B uniform. The Service Cap may be worn during ceremonies or when circumstances warrant.**
- 4. Directorates will determine exceptions, when appropriate (e.g., Soldiers TDY from theater, performing physical details or duties, and/or other duties where the wear of the ACU would be appropriate). Upon completion of those functions/duties, Soldiers will return to standard duty uniform.**
- 5. A one-time supplemental issue of the Defense Logistics Agency – Troop Support Procured ASU items will be provided to enlisted Soldiers on Active Duty (active Army, Army National Guard, and Army Reserve) assigned, attached or 'with permanent duty' at the Pentagon. This includes Soldiers assigned to the Army Staff, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the Office of the Secretary of Defense, and the Department of Defense. There is no sustainment associated with this one-time supplemental issue.**

SUBJECT: Wear of the Army Uniform for Personnel at the Pentagon

a. In order to support the 1 October 2011 implementation date, the one-time supplemental issue of ASU items to enlisted Soldiers assigned, attached or with permanent duty in the Pentagon is effective on or about 22 August 2011 for the following items:

<u>ITEM</u>	<u>BASIS OF ISSUE INCREASE</u>
White Shirts (SS)	2 each (male/female)
Trousers (male)	1 each
Slacks (female)	1 each

b. The Soldier's Supply Representative will submit the automated and approved DA Form 3078, Personal Clothing Request, for the one-time supplemental issue of ASU items from Army Military Clothing Sale Stores (AMCSS) at the Pentagon, Fort Belvoir, VA or Fort Myer, VA.

c. A Soldier assigned to the Pentagon who prefers to procure Army Green Uniform items may request them from the AMCSS at the Pentagon, Fort Belvoir or Fort Myer.
