SUBJECT: University of North Carolina (UNC) Strategic Studies Pilot Program Announcement

1. The Director, Army National Guard (DARNG) has approved Title-10 (T-10) and Title-32 (T-32) Captains to apply for participation in the 2013 UNC Strategic Studies Pilot Program. This program is sponsored by HQDA G-3/5/7 and hosted by professors from universities within the Chapel Hill, North Carolina research triangle area with the purpose of studying topics taken from the G-3/5/7 Key Strategic Issues List (KSIL).
2. HQDA, G-3/5/7 is seeking captains with Company Command experience to participate in this 5-week program held at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill from 25 June through 26 July 2013. Selected applicants are assigned a topic which they will study under the supervision of the research triangle's leading professors culminating with a capstone exercise. The officers will also be required to present a conclusions briefing led by a faculty panel and leadership from G-3/5/7. Successful completion of this program will be reflected on the Officer's Record Brief (ORB).
3. All interested candidates must submit iPERMS verified documents listed below along with a DA Form 4187 (Enclosure 1) to ARNG Human Capital Management Division (HCM) (Attn: LTC Ardis Porter, ardis.c.porter.mil@mail.mil) NLT 29 April 2013. Interested T-32 candidates must submit a packet through their state G1 to ARNG-HCM. HCM will provide a digital copy of the official documents to ARNG-TR for the panel to review. The following documents will be submitted:
 - a. Completion of the Captain's Career Course Certificate
 - b. ORB reflecting Company Command experience
 - c. OER confirming Company Command experience
 - d. DA 705 (Passed Height, Weight, APFT within the last six months)
4. The ARNG panel will consist of members from the G-3, G-5, HCM and ARNG-TR. ARNG-TR is the OPR for the panel process and will publish the results for final ARNG leadership approval. The purpose of the panel is to select five ARNG candidates to be submitted to HQDA G-3/5/7 for consideration NLT 10 May 2013.
5. HQDA will conduct the final selection panel from 20-24 May 2013 and the selectees will be announced on 24 May 2013.


