FLIGHT MEDICS (68WF3)

1. (U) SITUATION. THE EXPERIENCES IN OIF/OND, OEF AND DOMESTIC
SUPPORT OPERATIONS HAVE HIGHLIGHTED THE NEED FOR THE ADDITION OF
ADVANCED PRE-HOSPITAL CRITICAL CARE SKILLS TO THE MEDEVAC
MISSION. ANALYSES CONCLUDED A REQUIREMENT EXISTS TO PROVIDE
SPECIALIZED ADVANCED TRAUMA MANAGEMENT AT OR NEAR THE POINT OF
INJURY AND THUS IMPROVE PATIENT OUTCOMES. THESE ANALYSES ALSO
CONCLUDED THE MOST APPROPRIATE COURSE OF ACTION IS CERTIFIED
PARAMEDIC (NREMT-P/NRP) FLIGHT MEDICS WITH ADVANCED CRITICAL
CARE TRAINING.

2. (U) MISSION. THE ARMY MEDICAL COMMAND (MEDCOM) PROVIDES
ADVANCED NOTIFICATION OF A PLANNED CHANGE TO TRAINING
REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTY (MOS) 68W (ASI
F3) FLIGHT MEDICS TO THE NEW ARMY CERTIFICATION STANDARD OF
NATIONALLY REGISTERED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC
(NREMT-P/NRP) AND ANNOUNCES THE AVAILABILITY OF TRAINING.

3. (U) EXECUTION.

3.A. (U) TWO-PILOT CLASSES WILL BE CONDUCTED AT FORT SAM
HOUSTON, TX IN FY12 AND WILL BE LIMITED TO EXISTING PREQUALIFIED
FLIGHT MEDICS. THE FIRST-PILOT CLASS WILL BEGIN IN FEBRUARY
2012; THE SECOND-PILOT CLASS WILL BEGIN IN JULY 2012. THE
INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAM WILL BEGIN IN FY13 AND WILL BE OPEN TO
SELECTED 68W CANDIDATES (SL1-3) WHO MEET SPECIFIC SCREENING
CRITERIA. CAPABLE MOS QUALIFIED (MOSQ) 68W SOLDIERS SKILL LEVELS
SL1-3 ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENROLL IN THE PROGRAM. PREREQUISITES
AND APPLICATION PROCESS ARE LISTED IN PARA 3.F. OF THIS MESSAGE.

3.B. (U) TRAINING STRATEGY. TRAINING WILL BE CONDUCTED IN
THREE-PHASES.

3.B.(1) (U) PHASE-I IS THE CURRENT FOUR-WEEK TEMPORARY DUTY
(TDY) FLIGHT MEDIC COURSE AT THE SCHOOL OF AVIATION MEDICINE, FT
RUCKER, AL. CONSTRUCTIVE CREDIT FOR PHASE-I IS DESCRIBED IN
MILPER MESSAGE 11-344, (REGULAR ARMY PROCEDURES FOR AWARDED

ADDITIONAL SKILL IDENTIFIER (ASI) "F3" AND SKILL QUALIFICATION IDENTIFIER (SQI) "F").

3.B.(2) (U) PHASE-II CONSISTS OF A 26-WEEK NATIONAL REGISTRY ACCREDITED PARAMEDIC TRAINING PROGRAM AND CULMINATES WITH SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRY PARAMEDIC EXAMINATION. THIS PHASE REQUIRES A PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION (PCS) MOVE TO THE DESIGNATED TRAINING LOCATION (PILOT COURSE LOCATION IS FT SAM HOUSTON, TX).

3.B.(3) (U) PHASE-III CONSISTS OF AN EIGHT-WEEK CRITICAL CARE TRAINING COURSE FOLLOWING COMPLETION OF PHASE-II AND IS LOCATED AT FT SAM HOUSTON, TX.

3.C. (U) FUNDING. TRAINING COSTS FOR COMPO 1 SOLDIERS WILL BE COVERED BY THE AMEDD CENTER AND SCHOOL. COMPO 2 AND 3 TRAVEL, PAY AND ALLOWANCE COSTS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RESPECTIVE COMPONENT.

3.D. (U) ENROLLMENT PREREQUISITES.

3.D.(1) (U) PHASE-I: MOSQ 68W (EMT-B); CURRENT CLASS-III FLIGHT PHYSICAL; COMMAND REFERRED.

3.D.(2) (U) PHASE-II: MOSQ 68W WITH ASI F3 OR APPROVED WAIVER; SKILL LEVEL (SL) 1-3; COMMAND REFERRED.

3.D.(3) (U) PHASE-III: MOSQ 68W WITH ASI F3 (OR APPROVED WAIVER); NATIONAL REGISTRY EMT-P (NREMT-P) CERTIFIED.

3.E. (U) SERVICE REMAINING REQUIREMENT (SRR): THE SRR BELOW DESCRIBES THE MINIMUM TIME IN SERVICE REMAINING UPON COMPLETION OF TRAINING FOR INDIVIDUALS REQUIRING ALL THREE-PHASES.

3.E.(1) (U) COMPO 1 & 3 IS 27-MONTHS AS PER AR 614-200.

3.E.(2) (U) COMPO 2 IS 48-MONTHS PER NGB-ARH POLICY MEMO #06 081.

3.F (U) APPLICATION PROCESS: QUALIFIED 68W SOLDIERS WHO ALREADY POSSESS THE ASI F3 MUST PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION IAW PARA 3.F.(2) TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS PROGRAM. CURRENT ASI F3 SOLDIERS WILL NOT REQUIRE PHASE-I AND WILL INCUR A 26-MONTH SRR UPON COMPLETION OF PHASE-III OF THIS TRAINING. CURRENT ASI F3 SOLDIERS WHO ALREADY POSSESS NREMT-P CERTIFICATION WILL NOT REQUIRE PHASE-I OR PHASE-II AND WILL INCUR A NINE-MONTH SRR UPON COMPLETION OF PHASE-III OF THIS TRAINING.

3.F.(1) (U) MOS QUALIFIED 68W SOLDIERS IN SKILL LEVEL (SL) 1-3 INTERESTED IN BECOMING FLIGHT MEDICS MUST PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION IAW PARA 3.F.(2) BELOW TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS PROGRAM.
