



Army National Guard Readiness and Improvement Program (ARIP) Overview

NGB Training Division, Individual Training Branch



Purpose

Improving DMOSQ, NCOES, OES, AFAM and ATRRS validation, improve Unit Manning Roster (UMR) management and training, and increase SIDPERS data information accuracy and training.



- ARIP has nine analysts with assigned regions who conduct workshops at the states with all major stakeholders present to effect the changes needed to improve Soldier and unit readiness.
- ARIP management focus is to assist states in managing DMOSQ and Professional Development Requirements and backlogs and provide custom reports for a wide variety of metrics.
- ARIP coordinates training requirements to support state readiness goals.
- ARIP Regional Analysts serve as Subject Matter Experts for DMOSQ, PD, and Soldier Readiness issues at the state level by assisting units and G1/G3 representatives in all matters pertaining to improving Soldier and unit readiness.

ARIP Workshop

During workshops the ARIP team brings together the G-1, G-3, Security Manager, RSP, MSC, Battalion, and unit personnel to collectively review each Soldier's status and what is required based on a number of issues. These issues include previous training, length of time since their last MOS training course, clearance issues, vacancies, transfers, PD qualification, training seats, and the need to change a Warrior's AIT. These readiness review workshops will help empower State and unit personnel to make on-the-spot corrections to the UMRs.




State Workshop Activity

- Generate reports from custom data bases using AFAM, TAPDB-G, ATTRS.
- Discuss overview with workshop participants- State Training Officer, QSM, Ops NCOIC, G1/G3 reps, unit leadership.
- Review all Non DMOSQ and non PD qualified Soldiers records.
- Determine accuracy of databases, verify records.
- Determine MOS training requirements and identify courses of action.
- Review security clearance requirements.
- Establish status of Soldier, generate orders, move Soldiers, change reporting codes and/or schedule Soldier for training.


