

- URGENT ANNOUNCEMENT AFFECTING - FEDERAL TUITION ASSISTANCE

Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) will NOT be available at schools who do not sign the DoD Memorandum by December 31st 2011!!!

What does this mean? The Department of Defense (DoD) is requiring **ALL** schools who want to accept federal dollars for YOUR education to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). If your school has **NOT** signed the MOU before the new calendar year, you will NOT be able to utilize your Federal Tuition Assistance to pay for your classes that begin on or after January 1st 2012.

Who will this affect? This will affect **ALL** Soldiers currently using or planning to use Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) after 1 January 2012. It could greatly impact those currently enrolled at a school that chooses not to sign the Memo, especially those currently enrolled in a degree program.

What can you do? Contact your College, University, or Institution to determine their intentions on signing the DoD MOU. If your school does not sign, your tuition will need to be paid utilizing other sources of funding (possibly by using your GI Bill – check for eligibility) **or** you can choose to transfer to a different school who has signed and is eligible for FTA funding.
