The Gateway was created to serve the needs of the ARNG Personnel Community.

The purpose of the ARNG G1 Personnel Gateway is to create a one-stop shop for ARNG stakeholders to find Human Resources related information.

The Gateway is a solution created in response to three issues that directly impact the efficient delivery of essential personnel services:

- Frequent personnel turn-over
- Varied sources of information
- High OPTEMPO of the ARNG
