Gateway Sections



The **HR Community** section provides resources for ARNG HR professionals including program and system information, links to regulations, documents, and forms, as well as detailed overviews of processes including process maps and data dictionaries.



The **Soldiers** section features information on readiness, career management, deployment support, financial tools, medical benefits, educational resources, and duty-related programs and processes.



The **Families** section offers introductory information about the ARNG as well as resources such as deployment support and information on benefits including financial aid, education, and medical coverage.



The **Veterans & Retirees** section allows service members to locate benefit information, State Veterans Affairs resources, and encourages former ARNG Soldiers to stay connected with current ARNG initiatives.



The **Partners of the ARNG** section highlights and provides information for non-profits, corporations and organizations that support Soldiers and their Families including employer partners that employ Guard Soldiers.


HR Community

The HR Community section highlights the most current ARNG G1 processes, events, and priorities. In addition to information on the G1 organization, the section features a calendar and current events to increase awareness of G1 initiatives. The HR Community **Programs and Processes** section ensures that HR professionals in each of the 54 States and Territories have access to the most efficient and streamlined processes for vital HR functions including Accessions, Benefits, Medical Management, and Soldier Support & Services. Each page features extensive information on the function and access to related resources including forms and regulations. Additionally, process pages feature process maps and data dictionaries, two tools that offer detailed explanations of each step. The **Systems** section provides an overview of ARNG HR systems and databases, including information on access and training.

HR Process Guides

HR Process Guides are a printable packet of all information related to a process. Process maps illustrate the process step-by-step, and users can “CTRL + click” each box to find more information including a detailed description, related forms, applicable regulations or guidance, and the system or office responsible for each action or decision.
