MEMORANDUM FOR The Adjutants General of all States, Puerto Rico, the US Virgin Islands, Guam, and the Commanding General of the District of Columbia

SUBJECT: Clarification for Computing Additional Active Duty Days Authorized for Participation in Yellow Ribbon Reintegration Program (YRRP) Events (ARNG-HRH Policy #10-040a)

1. Reference Memorandum, NGB-ARH, 14 Jul 10, subject: Tracking and Reporting Procedures for Authorized Additional Active Duty Days for Participation in the Yellow Ribbon Reintegration Program (YRRP) for Army National Guard (ARNG) Soldiers (ARNG-HRH Policy #10-040).

2. Purpose. To provide clarification for the correct computation of additional active duty days authorized for mandatory attendance at YRRP events following redeployment.

3. Computation of additional active duty days authorized:

a. T-32/T10 AGRs: Additional active duty days are computed by taking the Soldier's leave balance (leave balance are the days remaining after leave already taken is subtracted) and adding it to the PDMRA days earned. In accordance with reference 1, paragraph 5f, the Soldier is authorized additional active duty days at the rate of 2, 4 or 6 days, if their leave balance and PDMRA total is between 30 and 90 days, or more. If the sum is greater than or equal to 30, additional days are added to the total days served/paid on the DD214 IAW reference 1 above. See Table 2 below for an example as to determining the total leave balance plus PDMRA:

Normal Accrued Leave Balance to the end of the Mobilization Order @ Out Processing	Subtract Leave Carried Forward	Subtract Leave Sold Back @ Out Processing	Equals Leave Requested @ Out Processing	Add PDMRA Earned	Equals Total Cumulative Leave/PDMRA @ Out Processing
75	-15	-30	=30	+30	=60


b. M-Day soldiers: Additional active duty days are computed by taking the Soldier's leave balance (leave balance are the days remaining after leave already taken is subtracted) and adding it to the PDMRA days earned. In accordance with reference 1, paragraph 5f, the Soldier is authorized additional active duty days at the rate of 2, 4 or 6 days, if their leave balance and PDMRA total is between 30 and 90 days, or more. If the sum is greater than or equal to 30, additional days are added to the total days served/paid on the DD214 IAW reference 1 above. See Table 2 below for an example as to determining the total leave balance plus PDMRA:

Normal Accrued Leave Balance to the end of the Mobilization Order @ Out Processing	Subtract Leave Sold Back @ Out Processing	Equals Leave Requested @ Out Processing	Add PDMRA Earned	Equals Total Cumulative Leave/PDMRA @ Out Processing
32	-10	=22	+30	=52

4. Soldiers whose leave and PDMRA balance is 29 days or less are not authorized any additional active duty days, regardless of conflicts due to YRRP events being scheduled sooner than 30 days post-mobilization.
