

2. This memorandum serves as a change to paragraph 5h of reference b. Paragraph 5h exempts State Command Sergeants Major (CSMs) serving in the AGR Program from the ASMB process. This paragraph is changed to read all nominative Command Sergeants Major serving in the AGR Program are exempt from the ASMB process. This exemption covers Division Command Sergeants Major and those CSMs serving at the convenience of the Chief National Guard Bureau, Director Army National Guard, Adjutant General and the Assistant Adjutant General. This change requires an update to paragraph 3b of Annex A to NGB-ARH Policy Memo #09-017.
