# IAP Problem Statement and Objectives

## Problem Statement

IRR Soldiers and their families do not have access to a local military network that can provide readiness related support and encourage their continued service to the Nation.

## Objectives

- Provide IRR Soldiers and their families a local network of support.
- Improve IRR Soldier readiness.
- Promote Continuum of Service.
- Retain Soldiers with valuable skills, Knowledge, abilities and experiences.



# IAP Updates

- Seven Pilot States participating AK, DC, KY, OR, VT, WI and WY
- Weekly teleconference being conducted with Pilot states by ARNG-HRH
- Over 4,000 Soldiers living within test States area of responsibility
- Second Edition of Commander's Handbook distributed to test states \*
- Tracking module fielded to capture reporting requirements \*
- RCMS workshop scheduled for 25-29 July to refine new module to manage IAP



# Implementation Plan- (Phase 1)

- Begins 1 July 2011
- ✓ Finalized and forwarded States data to HRC.
- ✓ Field RMS interim IT management system.
- ✓ HRC begins training AC Transition Points counselors.
- ✓ TAPDB-R IAP tables built (~ 180 days).
- ✓ HRC begins (20 Jul) affiliating IRR population (62K) to USAR and ARNG Pilot States.
- ✓ Coordinate with non Pilot States (Aug-Nov) to integrate into Phase 2.



# Implementation Plan- (Phase 2)

- 1 December 2011 – Projected start of Phase 2.
- AC Transition Points begins affiliation process for those members not entering the SELRES.
- New RCMS IAP module training and rollout.
- Begin affiliating RC Soldiers upon transfer to the IRR.
- Begin IAP of all ARNG units across the force.



# Next Step for Phase 2 Implementation

- Acceptance of remaining States for IAP participation
- Review entire listing of State UICs for IAP participation.
- Validate unit addresses, requires street address, No P.O. Box.
- Identify by name and phone number of UIC point of contact for support.
- Educate all participating units and POCs on IAP program.
- Identify State POC for oversight and coordination with ARNG-HRH.
