Description

The Department of Defense Medical Examination Review Board (DoDMERB) guides States through the medical phase of accessing special branch officers into the ARNG. Special branches include: AMEDD, Chaplain, JAG, and those applying for ROTC membership. This process is used for States in the medical phase of accessing special branch officers into the ARNG. This process exists because special branch officers follow a different accessions process than other applicants.
