

## **DAMPS-A Input Process: Soldiers utilize DAMPS-A to initiate application packet for WTU/CBWTU cadre positions**

### **Description**

DAMPS-A is a Web-Based, CAC, or AKO credentials authenticated application which replaces all paper documents required to initiate, track, approve, and mobilize a Soldier for WTU/CBWTU cadre positions. The DAMPS-A Input Process applies to Soldiers who have applied and been pre-approved by the seeking WTU/CBWTU location for an open WTU/CBWTU cadre position. NGB provides each pre-approved Soldier instruction on when and how to initiate his/her application packet in DAMPS-A.

## **Systems**

### [Department of the Army Mobilization Processing System-A \(DAMPS-A\)](#)

DAMPS-A is an unclassified web application developed by G-3/5/7, DAMO-ODM, to initiate, track, and approve reserve component (RC) volunteer packet requests for contingency active duty for operational support (CO-ADOS) tours. DAMPS-A allows RC soldiers and force requestors to submit packets on-line. Information is digitally extracted from authoritative databases to complete required data personnel fields then submitted electronically for command endorsement. Endorsed requests are then transferred into DAMPS-S for HQDA approval.
