

## **Prior and Non-Prior Medical Waivers Process: Obtaining a medical waiver regardless of prior service**

### **Point of Contact**

**Division:** Office of the Chief Surgeon (ARNG-CSG)

### **Description**

The medical waivers process is applicable to both prior and non-prior service Applicants who are joining the ARNG. As the Applicant progresses through the accession process, they will be subject to a complete medical physical exam at the Medical Detachment Facility or at the Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS) depending on State procedures. Should an Applicant fail to meet medical accession standards in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 2, Standards of Medical Fitness, the ARNG-CSG holds ultimate authority for approving the request for a waiver and allowing the Applicant to become a member of the ARNG.
