MEMORANDUM FOR the ARNG Education and Incentives Personnel of all States, Puerto Rico, The Virgin Islands, Guam and the District of Columbia.

SUBJECT: REB for Soldiers Non-DMOSQ due to Deployment

1. Reference. Memorandum, NGB-ARM, 10 August 2007, subject: Army National Guard (ARNG) Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP) Guidance for Fiscal Year (FY) 2007, 10 August 2007 – 31 March 2008 (Policy Number 07-06)

2. Soldiers not DMOSQ for the sole reason of being cross leveled for mobilization with a deploying unit and who are otherwise fully eligible for the incentive may be re-enlisted/extended for the Re-enlistment/Extension Bonus (REB). The initial bonus payment will be processed the same as if the Soldier was DMOSQ.

3. Strike out paragraph 14s(6)(b) of the above reference and replace with the following:

Soldiers who volunteer to remain in the cross-leveled MOS for which they are not qualified after REFRAD will fall under the following rules:

a. If serving on a 3 year REB, he or she will have 12 months to become DMOSQ from date of REFRAD.

b. If serving on a 6 year REB, he or she will have 36 months to become DMOSQ from date of REFRAD.

4. Soldiers who choose to not remain in the cross-leveled MOS for which they are not qualified must return to a position for which they are DMOSQ upon REFRAD or their bonus will be terminated with recoup.

5. Soldiers volunteering to remain in the deployed MOS who fail to become DMOSQ within the time constraints described in paragraph 3 above will have their incentive terminated with recoup. The first General Officer in the Soldier's chain of command may approve exceptions in cases where the inability to become DMOSQ is due to no fault of the Soldier.

6. Soldiers must be processed in iMARC under contract type "RB NON-MOSQ due to transition/deployment".

7. This guidance is effective the date of this memorandum and cannot be applied retroactively.
