SUBJECT: Exception to Policy for Enlisted Affiliation Bonus (EAB) Incentives

1. Reference: NGR 600-7, 26 March 1999
2. Effective immediately, an exception to policy for eligibility to receive the EAB is granted to all Soldiers that separated from the United States Army with Separation Program Designator (SPD) codes of JBK and LBK for reasons of being stop losted. Soldiers have to meet all other eligibility criteria to qualify for the EAB.
3. The separating Soldiers, DD Form 214, in the "REMARKS" section has to contain one of the following reason statements:
 - Stop-loss
 - Support of contingency operations
 - Involuntarily retained to support contingency operations
 - Voluntary agreement to stay on Active duty in support of contingency operations.
4. No exceptions to policy will be granted prior to the signature date of this memorandum.
