MEMORANDUM FOR the ARNG Education and Incentives Personnel of all States, Puerto Rico, The Virgin Islands, Guam and the District of Columbia.

SUBJECT: Changes to ARNG Education and Incentives courses for FY09

1. The following are changes to the remaining FY09 ARNG Education, Incentives, and Employment Division (NGB-EDU) courses offered at the ARNG Professional Education Center in North Little Rock, Arkansas.
2. NGB-EDU recently conducted a review of the Education Support courses offered at PEC and made some changes to the POI. In view of these changes, the following adjustments will be made to the class schedules:
  - a. Federal Tuition Assistance Manager Course (HRR-FTAMC): This course content will be incorporated into the HRR-ESOC course and all remaining HRR-FTAMC classes scheduled in FY09 (Class #102, 103 and 104) have been CANCELLED.
  - b. State GI Bill Managers Course (HRR-GI-BILL-MC): This course content will be incorporated into the HRR-ESOC course and all remaining HRR-GI-BILL-MC classes scheduled in FY09 (Class #102, 103 and 104) have been CANCELLED.
  - c. State Education Services Officer Course (HRR-ESOC): The course title has been changed to "Education Services Course". The class maximum has been increased to 40 students to accommodate all of the students from the cancelled courses shown above.
  - d. State Incentive Manager Course (HRR-IMC): The class dates of Class #104 have been changed as follows:
