MEMORANDUM FOR the ARNG Education and Incentives Personnel of all States, Puerto Rico, The Virgin Islands, Guam and the District of Columbia.

SUBJECT: CASP Enlistees Qualificaton for Either the CUIC or CS Bonus

1. Reference Memorandum, NGBEDU, 17 February 2009, Army National Guard (ARNG) Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP) Guidance Fiscal Year (FY) 2007, 2008, and 2009, 10 August 2007 30 September 2009 with updates.

2. This EIOM serves as clarification of the incentive policy governing a CASP enlistment being qualified for either the CS or CUIC bonus if they enlist for either a CS or a CUIC.

3. CASP enlistees who enlist for a critical skill are authorized the NPS CS Bonus.

4. CASP enlistees who enlist into a critical UIC are authorized the NPS CUIC Bonus.

5. To clarify this in current policy, the following subparagraphs are added:

a. To paragraph 6. b. :

(6) CASP enlistees are authorized this bonus if they enlist into a CUIC.

b. To paragraph 6. c.:

(6) CASP enlistees are authorized this bonus if they enlist into a CS.

c. To paragraph 6. e.:

(5) CASP enlistees who enlist for either a CUIC or CS may be considered for that respective bonus instead of the CASP bonus.
