SUBJECT: Selective Reserve Incentives with DESP/DUSP or equivalent declination

1. References:

2. In conjunction with EIOM 09-024, any Soldier/Officer/Warrant Officer in any Reserve component who is eligible for DESP/DUSP or equivalent, but chooses not to participate will not be authorized any Selective Reserve Incentives for 12 months from their ETS or obligated service date.
