MEMORANDUM FOR The Adjutants General, Directors of Logistics, Surface Maintenance Managers and United States Property and Fiscal Officers of All States, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, and the District of Columbia

SUBJECT: (All States Log Number I98-0230) FY99 Command Logistics Review Program (CLRP) for the Army National Guard (ARNG)

1. References:

2. The mission of the National Guard Bureau (NGB) Command Logistics Review Team (CLRT) is to improve the mobilization readiness and sustainability of the ARNG units, the effectiveness of ARNG logistical programs, and the stewardship of ARNG logistical resources. The CLRT accomplishes this mission through a periodic assessment and assistance program to the ARNG command and installation organizations. The CLRT serves as NGB's Command Supply Discipline Program (CSDP) review of the States, PR, VI, GU and DC, as well as logistical assessments of CONUS and OCONUS exercises IAW AR 710-2, Appendix B.

3. The CLRT reviews are conducted by visiting selected units and installations and reviewing predetermined assessment areas. This review results in a snapshot picture of the State's logistical health that is compared to other States of equal size and composition.

4. Scheduling of the CLRT visitations underwent a complete methodology change in FY96. Previously, the CLRT would visit

each State every three years. Currently, the time between visits can range from 9 months to 5 years based on the results of the CLRT assessment of the State. This new methodology allows the CLRT to readily focus on States requiring assistance and rewards those States that do well. The FY99 and tentative FY00 schedules are provided at enclosure one and two, respectively. Enclosure three lists the CLRP areas assessed and enclosure four outlines the CLRP process.

5. The FY98 CLRT Trends Information Papers for each area will be available on the ARL channel of the Guardnet II web site: <http://guardnet2.ngb.army.mil/>. The CLRT schedules and checklists will also be available at this site.

6. Comments from the States concerning how to improve the effectiveness of the CLRP in the ARNG are solicited. Suggestions should be forwarded to the undersigned.
