SUBJECT: (All States Log Number I01-0050) State Medical Detachment Redesign

1. A medical Table of Distribution and Allowance (TDA) Redesign workshop was conducted in June 2000 to begin the development of a new mission and organizational structure for the Medical Detachments. The next workshop is scheduled for 25 through 30 March 2001, during which the functions, tasks, and subtasks of the Detachment will be identified. Data gathered during that workgroup will be utilized to develop a workload driven TDA for implementation in CP04, effective 1 December 2003.
2. Communication is key to the development of a quality TDA which meets the needs of the States. To facilitate communication the Chief Surgeon will provide, on Army Guardnet, an information site that will include data developed during the TDA design process. Included on that site is a current Information Paper regarding the Medical TDA Study and a list of Workgroup members and their contact numbers.
