Reserve/Title 32 Active Guard Reserve Exchange Program

1. I have tasked the Full Time Support Division, Army Directorate to develop a Title 10 Active Guard Reserve (AGR)/Title 32 Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Exchange Program. The purposes of this program are to enhance professional development of our AGR force and to achieve a better understanding of our programs at the State and National level.
2. The Full Time Support Division conducted several work groups which developed a concept plan for the implementation of the exchange program. This program will allow an exchange of Title 10 AGR and Title 32 AGR personnel in all functional areas against valid full time support requirements for a specified period of time.
3. The exchange program affords a new approach to moving tour personnel with high career potential between the State and the National Guard Bureau. My goal is to ensure a continued and increased understanding of Guard programs while concurrently providing an experience base which would be helpful and profitable for selected personnel.
4. The enclosure contains information regarding the implementation of the program.
5. I solicit your support for this program and welcome your views and recommendations.

Title 10 AGR/Title 32 AGR Exchange Program

Eligibility: Title 10 AGR/Title 32 AGR personnel in the grades of 06/05/04/CWO and E8/E9 (senior E7s will be considered on an exception basis) are eligible to participate in the Exchange Program. Participation is voluntary, with the understanding that each participant must return to their original status upon completion of the exchange program. Exchanges may occur between two members of the same State or between members of different states.

Individual participating in the Exchange Program must have six (6) years remaining until Active Federal Service (AFS) or six (6) years until Mandatory Removal Date (MRD).

Exchange Positions: All exchanges will be accomplished within like functional areas. Example... Battalion Training Officer, MAJ, Title 32 asset may exchange with a Staff Action Officer, MAJ, Title 10 asset in the Directorate, Operation and Training, National Guard Bureau.

Assignment Length: Assignment length will remain flexible to allow for tailoring and program management, as an example National Guard Bureau action officer tours may be for three years and instructors at the Professional Education Center or Operational Readiness Evaluators may be limited to two years.

Officer Qualifications:

Military Education: Graduate of appropriate MEL school for present grade/rank.

Civilian Education: Baccalaureate degree mandatory.

Efficiency Reports: Must indicate potential for assignments of increased responsibility and difficulty.

Warrant Officer Qualifications:

Military Education: Graduate of appropriate MEL school for present grade/rank.

Civilian Education: High School diploma or equivalent.

Efficiency Reports: Must indicate potential for assignments of increased responsibility and difficulty.

Senior Enlisted Qualifications:

Military Education: Graduate of Advanced NCOES

Civilian Education: High School diploma or equivalent.

Efficiency Reports: Must indicate potential for assignments of increased responsibility and difficulty.

Nominations: Nominations for the Title 10 AGR/ Title 32 AGR Exchange Program will be initiated by the Adjutant General. Each nomination will be forwarded to the Chief, Full Time Support Division, Attn: NGB-ARP-FT, 4501 Ford Avenue, Alexandria, VA 22302
