MEMORANDUM FOR THE ADJUTANTS GENERAL OF ALL STATES, PUERTO RICO, GUAM, THE VIRGIN ISLANDS, AND THE COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

SUBJECT: Calendar Year 2005 (CY05) Officer and Warrant Officer Selective Retention Board (SRB) and Fiscal Year 2005 (FY05) Enlisted Qualitative Retention Board (QRB) (NGB-ARH Memo #04-029)

1. Based on the personnel tempo associated with current and projected operations, it is the intent of the Director, ARNG to continue allowing the states the flexibility to conduct the SRB/QRB as they deem appropriate.
2. Therefore, the following information is requested not later than 31 December 2004:
 - a. Date your state will conduct SRB in CY05. The SRB is conducted during the first six months of the calendar year as authorized in NGR (AR) 635-102, paragraph 4.
 - b. Date your state will conduct QRB in FY05. The QRB is conducted during the 2d quarter of the fiscal year as authorized in AR 135-205, Chapter 4.
 - c. Request, with justification, to exempt you from holding the boards-as outlined in paragraph 1 above.
3. If you elect to conduct your SRB/QRB for 2005, all officers/warrant officers/enlisted (soldiers) mobilized in support of Operations Noble Eagle, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF), are required to be reviewed.
4. All soldiers serving on AGR Title 32, Full-Time National Guard duty (T32, FTNGD) are required to be considered by the SRB/QRB. However, if the soldier is entitled to be credited with 18 or more years of active service (AS) on or before the date the board adjourns, the soldier will no longer be considered by the SRB/QRB. States will conduct Active Service Tour Continuation Boards (ASTCB) and all soldiers who will complete 20 or more years AS within the zone of consideration for the ASTCB will be considered.

1. Based on the personnel tempo associated with current and projected operations, it is the intent of the Director, ARNG to continue allowing the states the flexibility to conduct the SRB/QRB as they deem appropriate.

2. Therefore, the following information is requested not later than 31 December 2004:
