MEMORANDUM FOR Human Resource Officers (HROs) and Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Managers

SUBJECT: Exception to Policy to Waive the Retention Control Point (RCP) for Career Management Field (CMF) 79T T32 Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Soldiers (NGB-ARH Memo #05-018)

1. References:

a. AR 135-18, 1 November 2004, subject: The Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Program

b. Memorandum, NGB-ARH-S, 15 January 2004, subject: Memorandum of Instruction (MOI) for the Enlisted March 2004 ARNG AGR Active Service Tour Continuation Board (ASTCB)

2. T32 AGR Soldiers in CMF 79T may be allowed to serve in the AGR Program beyond their published RCPs for a period not to exceed two years, as directed by The Adjutants General. The period of this exception to policy is 1 October 2005 to 30 September 2006.

3. The Adjutants General will identify whether or not they wish to implement this policy. If this policy is implemented, the TAG may elect to retain specific grades only, or all grades within this CMF. All Soldiers within the same grade will be extended for the same period of time. The period of extension will be one or two years. Exceptions will not be granted to individual Soldiers.

4. This policy does not apply to Title 10 AGR Soldiers.
