MEMORANDUM FOR THE ADJUTANTS GENERAL OF ALL STATES, PUERTO RICO, GUAM, THE VIRGIN ISLANDS AND THE COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

SUBJECT: Calendar Year 2010 (CY10) Officer and Warrant Officer Selective Retention Board (SRB) Implementation Guidance

1. References:

- a. NGR 635-102, Officers and Warrant Officers Selective Retention, 1 July 1988.
- b. NGR 600-100, Commissioned Officers – Federal Recognition and Related Personnel Actions, 15 April 1994.
- c. NGR 600-101, Warrant Officers – Federal Recognition and Related Personnel Actions, 1 October 1996.

2. Purpose: Provide guidance on the execution of the CY10 SRB processing. The SRB is designed to review and select for retention, the best qualified officer personnel for further retention beyond 20 years of service. Reference 1a prescribes the policy for conducting the board.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all ARNG commissioned officers and warrant officers with the exception of those listed below.

- a. AGR (Title 32) Soldiers that have achieved or will have achieved 18 years active service, based on Basic Active Service Date (BASD), as of the date the board convenes.
- b. General Officers.
- c. State AGs and Assistant AGs.
- d. Commissioned and Warrant Officers in active Federal service on AGR status (Title 10 only).
- e. Command Chief Warrant Officers – Joint Force Headquarters.

SUBJECT: Calendar Year 2010 (CY10) Officer and Warrant Officer Selective Retention Board (SRB) Implementation Guidance

4. Based on the personnel tempo associated with current and projected operations, it is the intent of the Director, ARNG, to allow each State and Territory the flexibility to conduct a SRB as they deem appropriate. The Adjutants General may authorize the retention of Soldiers currently mobilized and those pending mobilization under Title 10 U.S. Code and have their records reviewed by the next CY SRB after demobilization.

5. States and Territories will provide NGB-ARH the convening dates for the SRB not later than 31 December 2009 and the final SRB results not later than 31 July 2010. Any requests for exemption from conducting the SRB must contain sufficient justification and be submitted to NGB-ARH not later than 31 December 2009.

6. Submit SRB results to NGB-ARH on the last day of the month following the month in which the board was conducted, but not later than 31 July 2010, using the format contained in the attached enclosure. The board cycle ends on 30 June 2010. Under the provisions of reference 1a, Appendices A, D & G, the results packet must include:

a. Cover memorandum signed by the state adjutant general approving the recommendations of the board.

b. Board proceedings signed by all board members.


c. List of officers recommended for selective retention.

d. List of officers not recommended for selective retention.

e. The selective retention board report signed by the board recorder.
