SUBJECT: Changes to ARNG Regular Evaluation (NCOER) Reports (ARNG-HRH Policy Memorandum #10-049)

1. References.

- a. AR 623-3, Evaluation Reporting System, 10 August 2007.
- b. DA Pam 623-3, Evaluation Reporting System, 13 August 2007.

2. Purpose. Announce changes in AR 623-3, Evaluation Reporting System for Army National Guard traditional (M-day) force.

3. Policy. Based on recent coordination with the proponent of AR 623-3, a rapid action revision was submitted to rescind table 5-2 of the regulation. The pending revision will eliminate the prescribed end of month annual rating period of August through November for the traditional (M-day) force. Effective 1 December 2010, States are authorized to implement the pending revision prior to the publication of the new regulation, at the discretion of the Adjutant General. ARNG reports will be event driven IAW reference 1a, paragraphs 5-17 through 5-20. Any references in paragraph 5-20b that do not correspond with the rescinding of table 5-2 will be completed IAW paragraphs 3-45 (Annual Reports) and 4-10b (USAR Annual Reports). Option reports are authorized IAW Chapter 3, Section IX of reference 1a.
