SUBJECT: Updated Guidance Concerning Invalidation of Puerto Rico Birth Certificates (ARNG-HRH Policy Memorandum #10-055)

1. Reference:

a. U.S. Department of State Office of Language Services Translating Division, L.S. No. 12-2010-0035, translation of Legislative Assembly of Puerto Rico Law 191-2009, Prohibiting Public and Private Entities from Retaining, Storing, or Holding Certified Copies of Birth Certificates.


b. Invalidation of Puerto Rico birth certificates (NGB-ARH Policy Memorandum #10-019), dated 19 March 2010.

c. Puerto Rico Law 68-2010, amending Section 6 of Puerto Rico Law 191-2009.

2. Purpose. To notify the force of the extension to the period of validity for current birth certificates issued in Puerto Rico.

3. Discussion. Further to reference 1c., paragraph 3b. of reference 1b. is changed to read, "Further, all PR birth certificates issued prior to 01 July 2010 shall be void as of 30 October 2010."
