MEMORANDUM FOR The Military Personnel Management Officers of all States, Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands and the District of Columbia

SUBJECT: Announcement of FY11 Army National Guard (ARNG) Accession Options Supplement, Edition 1 (ARNG-HRH Policy Memorandum # 11-010)

1. References.

- a. AR 601-210, Active and Reserve Component Enlistment Program, 8 February 2011.
- b. NGR 600-200, Enlisted Personnel Management, 31 July 2009.
- c. ARNG Enlistment Criteria Memorandum (ECM), 1 October 2006.

2. Background. Effective 8 March 2011, the major revision of AR 601-210 (reference 1a) combines the enlistment criteria for all three Army components, thereby making the ARNG ECM (reference 1c) obsolete. The enlistment options contained in Chapter 3 of reference 1c (also referred to as the ARNG Enlistment Options) will be managed outside of AR 601-210.

3. Policy.

a. This memorandum announces the FY11 ARNG Accession Options Supplement, Edition 1, with an effective date of 8 March 2011 (enclosed). This document will also be maintained electronically on the ARNG G1 Portal at <https://g1arng.army.pentagon.mil/Pages/welcome.aspx>.

b. Enlistment options are contained in both AR 601-210 and the ARNG Accession Options Supplement. The options/criteria available for States to enlist a Soldier into the ARNG are only contained in the ARNG document.

c. The ARNG Enlistment Criteria Memorandum (ECM), 1 October 2006, is rescinded effective 8 March 2011.


d. ARNG-HRH continues to manage ARNG accession options policy and will issue updated editions annually, or as required, to keep pace with changing requirements. State
