### Summary

Helmets to Hardhats is a national program that connects National Guard, Reserve and transitioning active-duty military members with quality career training and employment opportunities within the construction industry. The program is administered by the Center for Military Recruitment, Assessment, and Veterans Employment and headquartered in Washington, D.C. Direction for management of the center comes from a board of trustees comprised of equal numbers of employer and labor trustees. Employers looking to hire top quality candidates can sign up for Helmets to Hardhats Account where they can post career opportunities, and search for Veteran candidates in the Helmets to Hardhats database. Candidates can access information about careers and apprenticeships via the Internet. The Helmets to Hardhats profile they complete helps communicate to hiring managers the transferable skills they acquired during their military service.
