

The SPP establishes enduring and mutually beneficial partnerships between foreign countries and American States through the National Guard. This program is an important component of the Department of Defense's security cooperation strategy, the regional Combatant Commanders' theater engagement program, and the U.S. Ambassadors' Mission Strategic Plans. A primary aim is to promote partnership among the many nations working with the United States to advance security, stability, and prosperity around the globe. Today, American States are partnered with 60 foreign nations to focus on military-to-military, military-to-civilian, and civil security activities.
