

Active Duty Status Casualty Notification Process: When a Soldier is a casualty while on active duty status (IAW AR 600-8-1)

Description

AR 600-8-1 (Army Casualty Program) defines a casualty as any person who is lost to the organization by reason of having been declared beleaguered, besieged, captured, dead, diseased, detained, duty status whereabouts unknown (DUSTWIN), injured, ill, interned, missing, missing in action, or wounded. Units record all casualties on a Serious Incident Report (SIR) and forward to the appropriate State channels IAW State policy. SIR and appropriate documentation are forward to the supporting Casualty Assistance Center (CAC). Casualty Report (CR) initiates via DCIPS the official process of notifying the Casualty and Mortuary Affairs Operation Center (CMAOC), if applicable.
