

Death Occurring in a Non-Duty Status Notification Process: When a death occurs while a Soldier is not on active duty or in any type of duty status

Description

When a traditional non-active duty Soldier dies, the State may elect to identify personnel to assist the next of kin (NOK). Notification of the non-duty death is reported to both the State and ARNG. While all Soldiers are entitled to benefits, benefits and entitlements may vary based on duty status. Currently, non-duty status deaths are not reported to the Casualty Assistance Center (CAC).
