

Disassociated Remains Process: Notifying the person authorized to direct disposition (PADD) of disassociated remains

Description

Disassociated remains are referred to in some cases when additional partial remains may not have been recovered or may be recovered at a later date. The PADD completes the necessary forms regarding remains, to include: initial notification of identified remains and notification of subsequently identified partial remains.
