## **Informal Line of Duty (LOD) Process: Conducting an informal LOD and uploading necessary information into the LOD Module**

### **Description**

According to AR 600-8-4 (Line of Duty Policy, Procedures, and Investigations), line of duty investigations are conducted to determine whether misconduct or negligence was involved in the cause of the Soldier's disease, injury, or death and, if so, to what degree. Informal LOD investigations are conducted for cases in which no misconduct or negligence is suspected.

The purpose of this process is to provide a reference guide for Unit Administrators, Unit Commanders, State MILPO/Health Systems Specialists (HSS), State TAG/Reviewing Authorities, ARNG Personnel Division – Personnel Actions (ARNG-HRP-P) Analysts, and ARNG-HRP Approving Authorities when populating and approving informal LODs within the LOD Module. This process is only applicable for processing informal LODs for Title 10/OCONUS and Title 32/M-Day Soldiers within the LOD Module.

Note: This process only applies to informal LOD investigations.


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

1	Incur injury, illness, or disease	Soldier incurs an injury, illness, or disease.				The Soldier can attend the medical appointment before the information is entered into the LOD Module.
2	Receive notification of injury, illness, or disease	State MILPO/Health Systems Specialist (HSS), Unit Commander, and/or Unit Administrator receive notification of Soldier's injury, illness, or disease.				Injury, illness, or disease can be identified through multiple scenarios to include: Periodic Health Assessment (PHA), Soldier informing injury, illness or disease, Commander referral, Fit for Duty (FFD), Line of Duty (LOD), Post Deployment Health Assessment (PDHA), and Post Deployment Health Reassessment (PDHRA).
3	Initiate LOD (LOD Module)	Unit Administrator or the State MILPO/HSS initiates the LOD within the LOD Module to determine if the injury occurred in the line of duty.
