

Killed in Training or Operational Accident Process: Ensuring a Casualty Assistance Officer (CAO) is receiving investigation results and presenting results to next of kin (NOK)

Description

If a Soldier dies as a result of a military training accident, operational accident, or friendly fire, an investigator is appointed to conduct a collateral investigation into the accident. Casualty and Mortuary Affairs Operation Center (CMAOC) provides information on the Fatal Training/Operational Accident Program to the CAO. This program is mandated by the Army Chief of Staff.
