

Survivor Military ID Cards Issuing Process: Receiving new military ID cards after the death of a Soldier for the surviving Family

Description

Surviving dependents of deceased members Military ID Cards expire on the date of the member's death. The card must be renewed within 30 days of the member's death in order to continue to have access to the aforementioned privileges.

The Casualty Assistance Officer will make arrangements to receive a new card and will accompany the surviving dependents to the nearest Real-Time Automated Personnel Identification System (RAPIDS) site or other military installation authorized to issue ID cards. Surviving dependents should take the old ID card along with a copy of the DD Form 1300 to the issuing office. The old ID card may be used for identification until a card is obtained.
