

## **Survivor TRICARE Benefits Process: Determining eligibility and enrollment of Survivors in TRICARE after the death of a Soldier on active duty**

### **Description**

TRICARE is available to eligible Survivors of a Soldier who dies while on active duty. Eligible Survivors include the surviving spouse and children under the age of 21 or under the age of 23 if enrolled in a full-time course study in an institution of higher learning. Survivors are eligible for TRICARE Prime without reenrollment fees and copayments.
