

TRICARE Reserve Select (TRS) Process: To enroll Soldiers in the TRS health plan

Description

TRICARE Reserve Select is a premium-based TRICARE health plan that is available to members of the Selected Reserve at 28 percent of the premium cost. It is also available to eligible dependents. Soldiers who are not eligible for any other non-premium-based TRICARE health coverage can choose to qualify for and purchase this voluntary, premium-based health care plan. This process map provides an overview of how Soldiers apply for and enroll in TRS to include resolution of any issues related to eligibility errors.
